Introduction

ESCWA organized the First National Training on the Use of the Statistical Data and Metadata Exchange (SDMX) Standard for Reporting the SDG indicators.

The event provided hands-on training on data mapping and conversion using the SDMX standard tools as per international standards respecting a content constraint for disaggregation and adhering to the official SDGs framework, as well as hands-on examples using the SDMX Converter applications as well as a demo on the use of the ESCWA SDMX Converter in automating and updating the National Reporting Platforms (NRPs).

The virtual webinar consisted of three days of training, 3 hours a day, from 28 to 30 August 2023. The webinar featured presentations, demonstrations, and Q&A sessions. The participants completed handson exercises during the sessions.
