



Selecting indicators

Indicators selection is driven from the ICPD beyond 2014 review and the post 2015 agenda for development. Seven sub-indices are considered:

- 1) Dignity and human rights,
- 2) Health,
- 3) Population dynamics,
- 4) Mobility,
- 5) Environmental sustainability,
- 6) Human security, and,
- 7) Governance.














Why develop an ICPD-based SDG Index?

Population issues need to be grouped under one index and aggregating data on ICPD-based SDGs into a composite index will:

- 1) provide countries with a quick assessment of how they are performing relative to their peers.
- 2) guide national policies and long-term strategies for sustainable development.
- 3) allow countries to benchmark themselves using a single holistic measure that encompasses ICPD-based SDGs.
- 4) support national discussions on operationalizing the SDGs.

Who will use the index?

- Policy/decision makers
- Parliamentarians
- Politicians
- Media

How to use the index?

- On the national level
- On the local level
- On the sectorial level

Challenges?

- Institutional framework for monitoring
- Data availability and data governance

Data challenges?

Governance

- Who should decide on priorities?
- Who should collect data?
- Who should decide on availability (level/timing)?
