About the side event

Artificial intelligence (AI) and other 4th industrial revolution technologies can be SDG accelerators. Recognizing the potential, several Arab countries are pressing forward with these technologies, seeking to deploy them in sectors including government services, manufacturing, agriculture, data collection and others. If skills in the region continue to be stuck in the past, and issues of ethics, inequalities, privacy and cyber security remain unaddressed, the benefits of these technologies will accrue to few countries and few societal groups within, while others are left behind.
