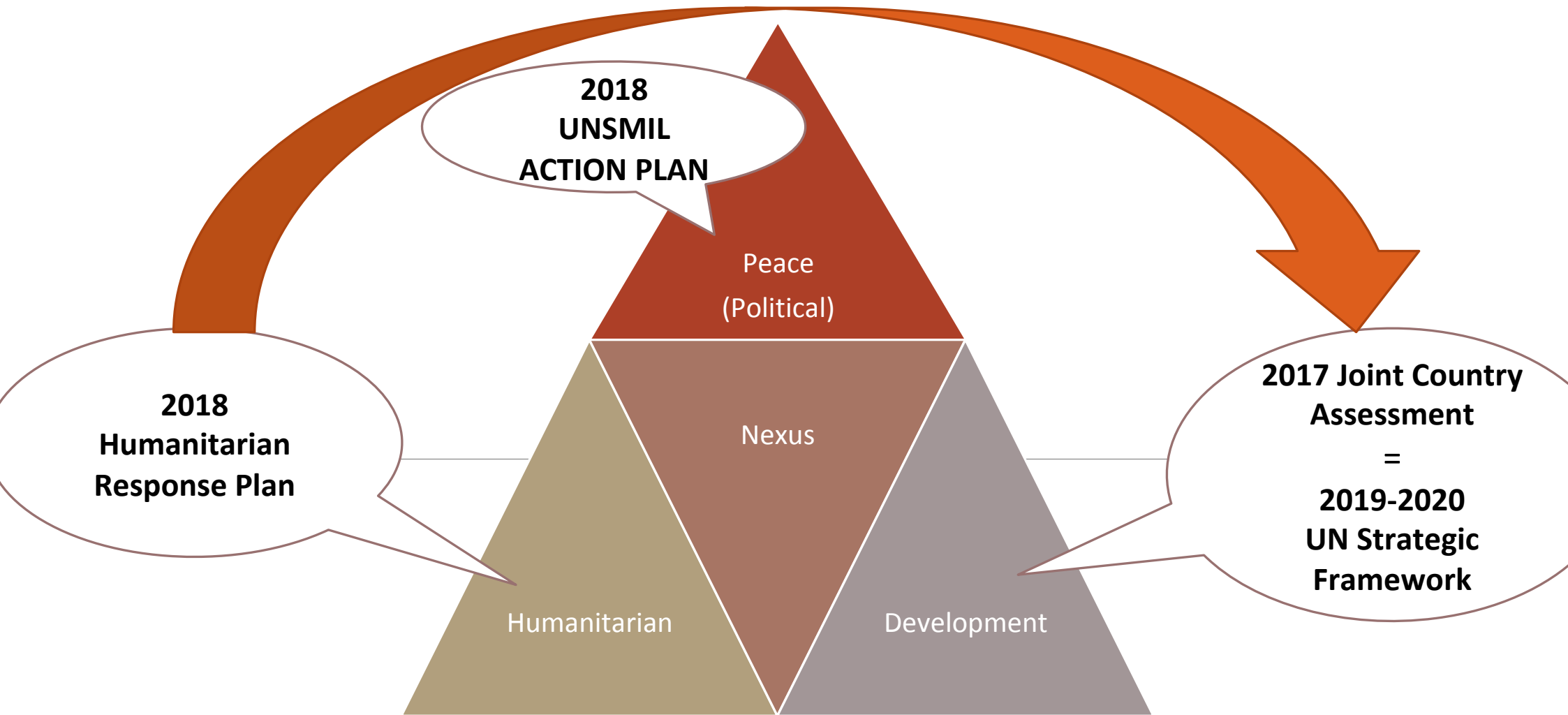

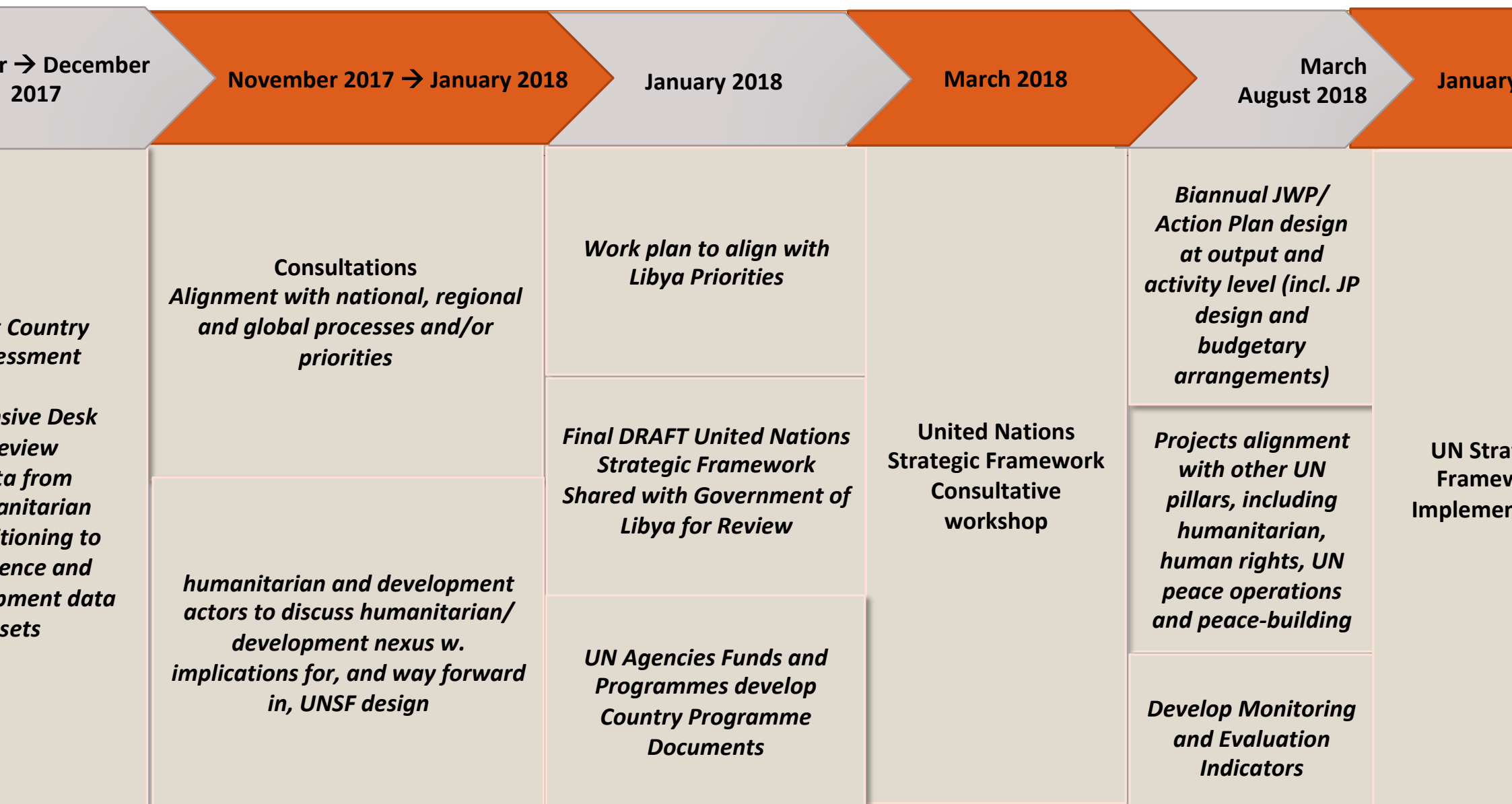

Governmental priorities as per the Coordination Framework for International Cooperation for Libya.

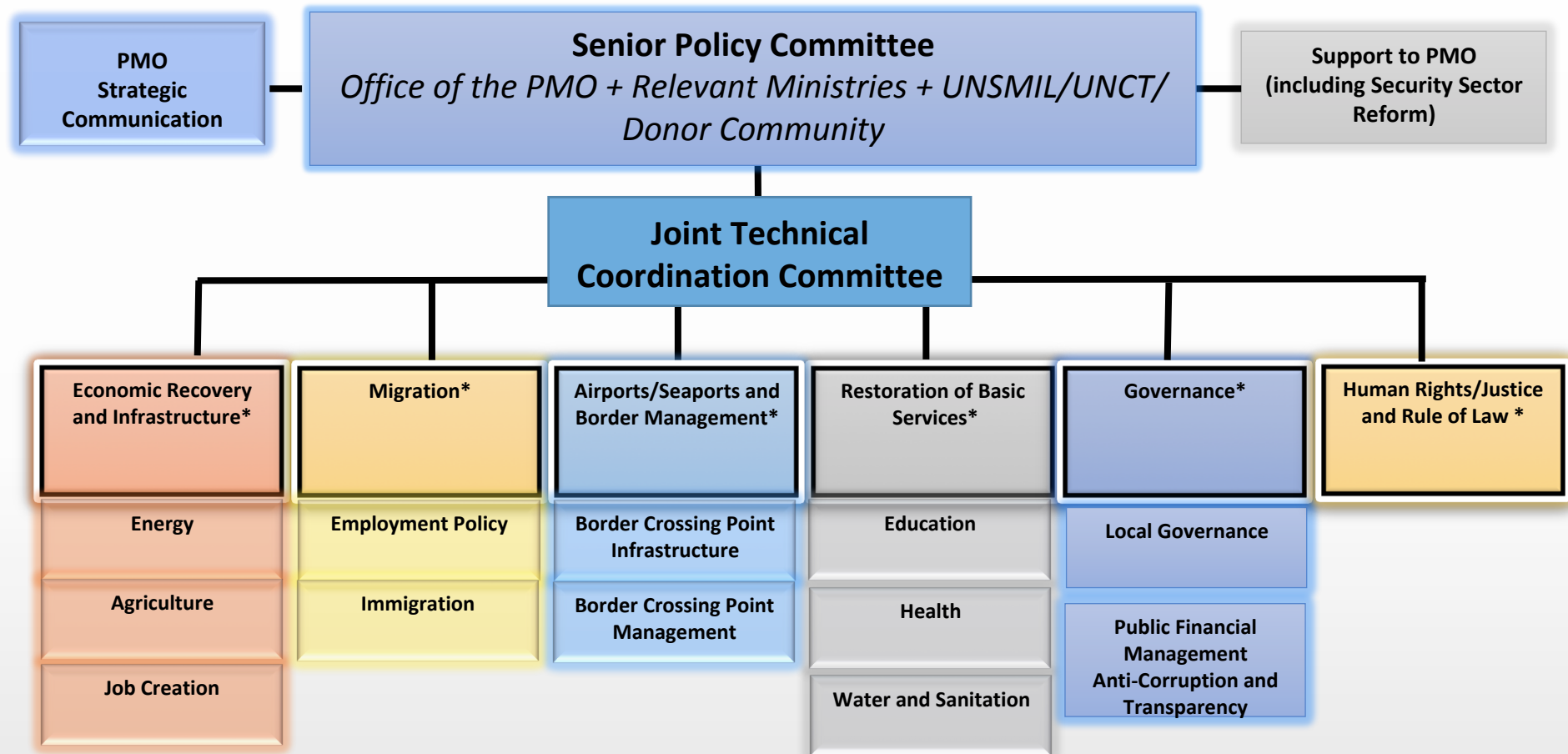
